MUMBLES WEEK 31st July, 2010 to 3rd August, 2010.

NOTICE OF RACE.

1. Rules.

- 1.1 The regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Appropriate class rules will apply.
- 1.3 Local Sailing Instructions will apply and will be available at registration.

2. Eligibility and Entry.

- 2.1 The event is open to all classes of boat.
- 2.2 Entry forms are available on the MYC web site or can be obtained at the club at registration.
- 2.3 Competitors under the age of 16 years at the time of the event are required to provide a parent/guardian consent form at registration.
- 2.4 Registration will take place from 08.30 hrs on Saturday, 31st July, 2010. Competitors not racing for the full event but on days other than the Saturday can register on the morning of the day they race at a time to be announced.

3. Fees.

- 3.1 Entry for MYC members for the event is free.
- 3.2 Entry for non-members is £10.00 per day for Mumbles Week. Alternatively, for Mumbles Week competitors, country membership might be an alternative for persons wishing to use MYC more frequently. Details of membership fees can be found on the MYC web site.

4. Schedule.

- 4.1 A briefing for competitors will take place at 08.45 hrs. on 31st July, 2010, on the first floor of Mumbles Yacht Club.
- 4.2 Dates and approximate start times of races.

Saturday, 31st July, 2010 - Race 1 - 10.00hrs. Race 2 asap after Race 1 finishes.

Sunday, 1st August, 2010 - Race 3 - 10.00hrs. Race 4 asap after Race 3 finishes.

Monday, 2nd August, 2010 - Race 5 - 10.00hrs. Race 6 asap after Race 5 finishes.

Tuesday, 3rd August, 2010 - Race 7 - 12.00hrs. Race 8 asap after Race 7 finishes.

5.Venue.

5.1 Racing will take place within the confines of Swansea Bay.

6.The Courses.

6.1 It is intended to use ‘windward/leeward’, triangular or trapezoid courses, depending on the classes involved. More details will be available in the Sailing Instructions.

6.2 Variations to these courses may be made at the discretion of the Race Committee, depending on local conditions, class entries, etc.

7. Scoring.

7.1 The low point system of RRS Appendix A will apply.
